RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LOCAL MATCH FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION FOR THE RAIL DEPOT DEMOLITION

WHEREAS, an opportunity exists for the City of Pickens to aid the residents of Pickens, especially the low to moderate income residents, by applying for a CDBG Community Enrichment grant from the SC Department of Commerce, Grants Administration; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG grant would be used to demolish the Rail Depot facility including the buildings, exposed foundations and concrete slabs, and a portion of the wall along East Cedar Rock Street and prepare for the redevelopment of the Rail Depot site at 124 Railroad Street; and,

WHEREAS, City of Pickens must commit \$18,866.00 as a local cash match in order to receive a \$169,790.00 CDBG grant, and any costs that exceed the grant amount:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Pickens commits the \$18,866.00 local cash match from the Hospitality Fund to the Rail Depot Demolition Project, for the payment of costs associated with the project, for the Community Development Grant if awarded to the City of Pickens. City of Pickens also commits to the payment of any other costs associated with the project that are over the \$169,790.00 covered by the grant and the local match.






