9. Any Unscheduled Matters/Miscellaneous Business

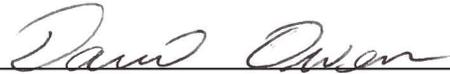
Council Member Perry mentioned an incident at Garren's Café the prior weekend. There was discussion of cameras on Main Street.
