1. Invocation

2. Call Regular Session to Order

3. Comments from Citizens

Ken Acker spoke on being named the Active Administrator for Pickens County in lieu of Gerald Wilson stepping down from the position. Lisa Turner read a letter that was dropped off at the Chamber of Commerce but addressed to the City on cyclist/pedestrian traffic.

4. Contract Approval for Acker, Lambert, & Hinton (Sean Hinton)

The Bradley-Boggs House as well as the possibility of relocating the face of the home to Hagood Mill was discussed among Council. Council Member Welborn asked for updates on the progress of Hooper Field lighting. Bruce Field's lighting/parking was discussed amid Council. Council Member Lark questioned City Administrator, David Poulson, on the movement of the Ordinance pertaining to Sunday Alcohol Sales (Referendum). Council Member Perry questioned the time frame to upgrade the UV lights at the Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP).
