

Shifting Plates II

Shifting Plates II, the second print exhibition directed by Steven Chapp of Black Dog Press and Studio, is a two part print exhibition consisting of 32 original prints by 16 South Carolina printmakers. It is Chapp's intention not only to get a great body of work together for an exhibit but to help inform the general public to gain some insight into the complexities of the printed image. Shifting Plates II consists of a range of printmaking media and techniques that makes for a very informative exhibit. You will see wood cuts and engraving, dry point, stone lithography, reduction linocuts, screenprinting, intaglio from photopolymer, & metal plates and monotypes.

Shifting Plates II is funded in part by the Metropolitan Arts Council with funds received from the City of Greenville, BMW Manufacturing Company, Michelin North America, Inc., SEW Eurodrive and the South Carolina Arts Commission. 
