TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PICKENS TO CLOSE A  
PORTION OF THE PUBLIC ROAD KNOWN AS DEAN STREET LOCATED IN THE  
CITY LIMITS OF PICKENS, SC


WHEREAS, S.C. Code Ann. §57-9-10, et seq., authorizes municipalities to petition the court to abandon or close any street, road, or highway; and,

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor have determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Pickens to close an unimproved portion of Dean Street, a public street owned by the City of Pickens, for the purpose of conveying a privately owned driveway to the property owner of 400 Dean Street, Pickens, SC. The portion of the road sought to be closed is shown on the highlighted portion of the survey recorded in the Pickens County Register of Deeds Office in Plat Book 295 at Page 17 attached hereto.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Members of Council of the City of Pickens, in Council assembled that:

Section 1. The City Attorney is authorized to initiate a proceeding to close a portion of Dean Street.


