

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LOCAL MATCH FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION FOR THE PICKENS NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, an opportunity exists for the City of Pickens to aid the residents of Pickens, especially the low to moderate income residents, by applying for a CDBG Community Enrichment grant from the SC Department of Commerce, Grants Administration; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG grant would be used to demolish vacant and dilapidated buildings and for the installation and repair of new and existing sidewalks in the neighborhood south of Main Street; and,


WHEREAS, City of Pickens must commit \$47,523.00 as a local cash match in order to receive a \$475,230.00 CDBG grant, and any costs that exceed the grant amount:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Pickens commits the \$47,523.00 local cash match from the General Fund and Stormwater Fund to the Pickens Neighborhood Revitalization Project, for the payment of costs associated with the project. City of Pickens also commits to the payment of any other costs associated with the project that are over the \$475,230.00 covered by the grant and the local match.


